ENABLING ONLINE PROCTORING

A GUIDE FOR SCORPION™ FREE USERS

Requirements

- 1. You must have proctors who can work remotely online and have the "Admin" role in your Scorpion Project.
- 2. You need your own scheduling process to link proctors and students. This could be:
 - a. An LMS that is integrated to your Scorpion project via the LTI integration.
 - b. As simple as using a Google/Outlook Calendar to schedule proctors and students/candidates.
 - c. A commercial scheduling software like Doodle.
- 3. The proctors must have access to commercial-level screensharing and video conferencing software (VCS) like Zoom, GoToMeeting, Microsoft Teams, Skype, etc. (Note: Free versions of these tools will not usually work.) Zoom will allow for one user to manage multiple separate meetings. Instructions for that can be found here:

Launching exams via the launchpad (no LMS integration)

- 1. Candidate logs into the proctor's video conference (Zoom, GoTo, etc.) and shares their audio, video, and screen with the proctor.
- 2. Proctor logs into Scorpion and goes to the "Delivery" tab.
- 3. Proctor clicks the black "Proctor This Exam" button at the bottom of the page, which will launch the proctor controls in a new tab.
- 4. Proctor copies the link from the field directly beneath the setting called "Enable a URL where users can launch their own exams" on the "Delivery" tab. Note: If this setting is not enabled, the proctor will need to enable the setting and click the "Save" button in the upper right-hand corner before the link will appear.
- 5. Proctor pastes the launchpad link into the chat area of the video conference tool and instructs the student to click on it.
- 6. Proctor navigates to the tab opened for the proctor controls in step 3 above.
- 7. Proctor clicks on each student's name and clicks the "Resume" button to allow each student to enter and begin their exams.
- 8. Students take the exam. Proctor has the ability to pause/stop the exam if needed.
- 9. When a student completes the exam, the proctor closes the VCS.

Launching Exams with LTI Integration to LMS Enabled:

- 1. The proctor must follow steps 1 through 3 above.
- 2. The proctor **will NOT** provide the launchpad link to the students as described in step 4 and 5 above.
- 3. Instead, proctors will direct their students to the LMS module that houses the exam. This set up is different for each LMS and should be done ahead of time to ensure a smooth experience for the students as they try to launch the exam.
- 4. Once students have launched the exam from their LMS, the process is the same from steps 6 onward.
